Boston Lyric Opera announces auditions for local AGMA singers for chorus and role consideration for the 2025-2026 Season. Auditions will take place between Wednesday February 5th – February 8th, 2025, in Boston, MA. Local AGMA artists are invited to request an audition. An accompanist will be provided, but singers may bring their own. Please prepare at least three arias of your choice. Repertoire for the 2025-2026 Season has not yet been announced.

Materials must be received no later than **January 5th 2025, 5:00pm EST**.
AGMA members are asked to be sure their union affiliation is indicated clearly on their résumés in the upper right-hand corner.

Singers selected to audition will be notified by email by **January 13th, 2025**.
